Individuals Gain*

Relationships: meeting new people, strengthening existing bonds
Well-Being: pride, confidence, physical and mental health benefits, self-improvement, belonging
Experience: job placement, socialization, recreation
Knowledge: opportunities to participate, understand civil society, employment opportunities, community knowledge, awareness of others' perspectives, common interests
Skills: employment, listening, social, self-management, health, leadership

Behaviour Changes*

Increased civic engagement
More likely to try new things (don't presume "no")
Empowered interaction with Agencies and Institutions

Improved critical thinking
Improved listening
Increased social interaction
More social mixing
